President Felps established a quorum through a roll call of Directors; declared a quorum present; and called the Meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

President Felps then asked for public comment. There was no public comment.

President Felps then asked for consideration and/or action on the Minutes of the Regular Board Meeting held June 20, 2014.

Bill Felps moved to:

Vote on the motion carried.

President Felps then asked for consideration and/or action on Expenditures for June 2014 and July 2014; Review of 2013-2014 Budget; Consideration and/or action on Budget Line Item Adjustments and a Quarterly Report on Investments.

Steve Henderson moved to:

Approve the Expenditures for June 2014 and July 2014.

Second was by Bill Luedecke.

Vote on the motion carried.

General Manager Shell reported that the following line item adjustments would be made within a budget category to the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Budget:

Move \$100.00 from Technical Operations Filed Equipment to Technical Operations Lab Equipment Move \$800.00 from Other Expenses Registration Fees to Other Expenses Staff Education Move \$4000.00 from Payroll Expenses Intern and/or FTE to Payroll Expenses Salary & Wages Move \$7,000.00 from Payroll Expenses Health Insurance to Payroll Expenses Salary & Wages Move \$1,000.00 from Payroll Expenses Health Insurance to Payroll Expenses Payroll Taxes

General Manager Shell reported that the following line item adjustment would need to be made between budget categories to the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Budget:

Move \$1,000.00 from Contract Services Legal to Office Expense Telephone

Bill Luedecke moved to:

Approve a budget line item adjustment to move \$1,000.00 from Contract Services Legal to Office Expense Telephone in the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Budget.

Vote on the motion carried.

Public Funds Investment Officer, Donnita Coats, gave the Board a Quarterly Report on the Investment Position of the District for the quarter ending June 30, 2014 in accordance with Section IV of the Public Funds Investment Policy of the District.

President Felps then asked for consideration and/or action on an engagement letter from Taber & Burnett, P.C. for the District's 2013-2014 Audit. General Manager Shell reviewed the letter and cost of the audit.

Wayne Brown moved to:

Approve Taber & Burnett, P.C. to do the 2013-2014 Audit for the District.

Second was by Bill Luedecke.

Vote on the motion carried.

President Felps then asked for consideration and/or action on amendments to and/or re-adoption of the District Investment Policy. The Investment Policy of the District requires the District to review the Investment Policy at least annually and adopt a resolution confirming the continuance of the Investment Policy without amendment or adopt an Amended Investment Policy. General Manager Shell informed the Board that it was not necessary to amend the current policy at this time.

## Wayne Brown moved to:

Adopt a Resolution confirming the continuance of the District Investment Policy without amendment.

Second was by Steve Henderson.

Vote on the motion carried.

President Felps then asked for consideration and/or action on the 2015 Benefit Selections for the Texas County & Districts Retirement Plan (TCDRS). General Manager Shell presented and reviewed the TCDRS 2015 benefit selections and plan rates as compared to the 2014 Plan.

Bill Felps moved to:

Approve the 2015 Benefit Selections and Plan Rates for the Texas County & Districts Retirement Plan as presented.

Second was by Dan Brady.

Vote on the motion carried.

President Felps then asked for consideration and/or action on Resolutions Providing for the Sale of Property Acquired by the Burnet Central Appraisal District at Delinquent Tax Sale.

Steve Henderson moved to:

Approve the Resolutions Providing for the Sale of Property Acquired by the Burnet Central Appraisal District at Delinquent Tax Sale.

Second was by Wayne Brown.

Vote on the motion carried.

President Felps then asked for consideration and/or action on a Proposed FY 2014-2015 Budget for the District. General Manager Shell reviewed a proposed FY 2014-2015 Budget and discussed projects that the Board may want to consider and funding those projects with reserves.

Bill Luedecke moved to:

Approve the Proposed FY 2014-2015 Budget as presented.

Vote on the motion carried.

President Felps then asked for consideration and/or action on the 2014 Proposed Tax Rate. General Manager Shell informed the Board that the effective tax rate for 2014 was .0096/\$100 for a total tax of \$447,251.00.

Approve a Proposed 2014 Tax Rate of 0.0096/\$100

Vote on the motion carried.

President Felps then asked for consideration and/or action on Determination of the Drought Stage. Hydrologist Sodek reviewed observed rainfall, the seasonal outlook, and monitor well levels. He recommended to the Board that we remain in the Stage 2 – Moderate Drought Stage at this time. No action was taken to change the Drought Stage.
